SUBJECT : CREATION OF A TEAM TO CONDUCT PERFORMANCE EVALUATION OF FURNITURE GROUP, INC. (FGI) AND STAR VENEER MANUFACTURING CORPORATION (SVMC), FORMERLY NAGAN AGRO-FOREST DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO DETERMINE THE ACTUAL DAILY RATED CAPACITY OF THE VENEER PLANT INTENDED TO BE LEASED/PURCHASED BY STAR VENEER MANUFACTURING CORPORATION (SVMC) FROM FURNITURE GROUP, INC. (FGI).

In the interest of the service and in order to determine the actual Daily Rated Capacity of the Veneer Plant intended to be leased/purchased by SVMC from FGI to be separated from the daily rated capacity of its Sawmill Plant and to obtain reliable data as basis in granting a separate Wood Processing Plant Permit and in order to determine the degree of compliance of both companies to the terms and conditions of their Agreements, a team is hereby created to be composed of the following:

The team shall undertake the following activities:

1. Conduct mill study to determine the individual actual daily rated capacity of the veneer and sawmill plant of FGI.
2. The team shall take pictures of the plant machineries together with their accessories.
3. The team shall evaluate the overall performance on the operation and developmental activities for CY 2002-2004 of both companies using the Revised Performance Evaluation Guidelines.

4. The Team is hereby authorized to seek the assistance of any official/personnel in the Regional Offices, PENROs and CENROs services thereof necessary to carry out the activity.
5. The Team shall submit their report to the Secretary thru the Director, Forest Management Bureau within fifteen (15) days after the completion of their field work.
6. They shall be entitled to reasonable transportation expenses, allowance and per diems subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations chargeable against the funds intended for this purpose of their respective offices.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
