Two Representatives from the Rank-and-File (One for the 1st level and another for 2nd level who

shall serve for a term of two years)

- Member

The OIC, Welfare and Discipline Section, Personnel Division

- Bilis Aksyon Partner

The Chief of the Personnel Division with the assistance of a staff member, shall act as Secretariat and shall be the custodian of all records of the Committee.

The Committee is hereby authorized to seek the assistance of any DENR official or employee in pursuance of this Order and shall be guided by CSC MC No. 02, S. 2001 in the performance of its functions. It shall find the best way to address specific grievances.

In addition, the Committee shall have the following responsibilities:

- 1. Establish its own internal procedures and strategies;
- 2. Develop and implement pro-active measures or activities to prevent grievances such as employee assembly, counseling and other HRD interventions;
- 3. Conduct dialogue between and among the parties involved;
- 4. Direct the documentation of the grievance including the preparation and signing of written agreements reached by the parties involved.

All grievance cases shall be attended to in the most expeditious manner so as to dispense timely action.

This Order takes effect immediately and revokes/amends previous Orders inconsistent herewith.
