SUBJECT : Creation of a Special Review Committee to Review, Evaluate and Recommend Eligible/Qualified Projects to be Supported by the Air Quality Management Fund

In the interest of the service and in order to effectively manage and operationalize the Air Quality Management Fund (AQMF) established pursuant to the Republic Act 8749 also known as the Clean Air Act of 1999, a Special Review Committee is hereby created to carry out the abovementioned task in addition to their regular function.

The Special Review Committee shall compose of the following EMB personnel:

This Committee shall have the following duties:

1. Prepare a detailed set of criteria (project design, management, reporting and accounting) of qualified or eligible projects and activities to be supported by the AQMF;
2. Review and evaluate with the set of detailed criteria specified in item no. 1;
3. Submit report and recommendation to EMB Director regarding item 2 for his/her perusal and approval;
4. Formulate procedures and standards which will describe the mechanisms to review and evaluate proposals as well as maximum response time in order to promote transparency and accountability; and
5. Perform other functions as may be directed by the EMB Director.

As such, all expenses that shall be incurred by this Committee in the discharge of its functions shall be charged against the AQMF subject to pertinent rules and regulations.

This order shall take effect immediately.
