**SUBJECT** 

CREATION OF A RECORDS MANAGEMENT IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE (RMIC) IN THE CENTRAL OFFICE

Pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 9470 dated May 21, 2007 and in compliance with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) Order No. 13-A, series of 1988, a Records Management and Improvement Committee is created to serve as an Advisory Body on matters of Records Disposition Schedule and other matters towards the improvement of its systems and procedures.

The Committee shall be composed of the following:

## The Committee shall perform the following functions:

- 1. Formulate new policies and guidelines in the creation of communications/administrative issuances;
- 2. Formulate policies and guidelines for the identification and preservation of records of permanent value and the sale/destruction of valueless records;
- 3. Review or amend the Records Disposition Program to solve problems of space, time and money;
- Create sub-committees represented by the various units maintaining records to conduct inventory, evaluation and determination of time and utility value and retention periods of records; and
- Coordinate with the Records Management and Archives Office, DECS and COA concerning records management matters.

The Committee shall convene regularly or whenever necessary upon the call of the Chairman and submit recommendation to the Secretary in support of its objectives and functions.

All expenses to be incurred by the above mentioned officials in the performance of their duties and responsibilities as members of the Committee shall be chargeable against the agency fund subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing.
