SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO SPECIAL ORDER 2015-1104 ON THE DESIGNATION OF THREE (3) ADDITIONAL POLLUTION CONTROL OFFICERS (PCOs) IN THE DENR CENTRAL OFFICE

In line with the program implementation of Environmental Management System (EMS) and in compliance with the legal requirements of ISO 14001:2015 standards, the following EMS Core Team members are hereby designated as Pollution Control Officers (PCOs) in addition to the existing PCOs:


1. Encarmila B. Panganiban
2. Ar. Jamille Vanessa E. Saplagio, EnP.
3. For. Mark Vincent C. Yngente

As such they shall perform their duties in accordance with their designations:

1. Design, implement and monitor the Pollution Control Program for the DENR Central Office pertaining to various in-house environmental activities such as solid waste management, smoke emission tests, construction and maintenance of sewer system and other environmental aspects related to water, air and land pollution;
2. Act as Focal Person(s) for the Department's pollution control and prevention/mitigation activities;
3. Regularly check compliance of the Department to pollution regulation requirements which shall be submitted to the DENR-NCR quarterly (Self-Monitoring Report) and semi-annually (Compliance Monitoring Report);
4. Report quarterly to the Chair, DENR-EMS on the status of implementation of the Pollution Control Program and other observations/findings of abnormalities or malfunctioning devices/systems, and the recommendations for corrective and preventive actions; and
5. Perform other responsibilities as stipulated under DENR Administrative Order No. 2014-02 on the appointment/designation of PCOs.

They shall initiate actions towards their official accreditation as Pollution Control Officers.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
