The Secondary Representatives shall assist the PEMSEA National Focal Point of the Philippines on matters pertaining to the compliance of national and regional agreements. The Sectoral Focal Points shall ensure that activities under national and regional agreements are fully implemented and documented for access and dissemination.

In the performance of their duties and responsibilities, the designated Secondary Representatives and Sectoral Focal Points shall maintain close coordination and provide necessary support to the PEMSEA National Focal Point of the Philippines, and represent the country in PEMSEA events, as needed.
