**SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF INTER-AGENCY  
CONVERGENCE: YOUTH FOR ENVIRONMENT  
INITIATIVES**

In the interest of service and in celebration of the 2021 Month of the Ocean, the activity entitled “*Inter-Agency Convergence: Youth for Environment Initiatives*” is hereby authorized to be conducted on May 31, 2021, from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM via Zoom video conferencing application.

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources, as one of the National Youth Commissions recognized partners in promulgating programs, projects, and activities that are vital to the development and welfare of our young Filipino citizenry, through our National Youth Desk under the Strategic Communication and Initiatives Service, will spearhead this partnership-building and learning event.


The activity will be attended and participated in by Philippine government agencies under the Executive Branch, in order to generate and plan sustainable programs/projects, campaigns, and policies that will provide opportunities that will harness enormous positive benefits to help not only in the self-enrichment of our nation’s youth, but also in the betterment of our society, and environment. The said event will also serve as an avenue to foster strengthened collaborations between and among the country’s major government agencies, to create sustainable solutions to existing environmental predicaments, where the youth’s support and help may greatly contribute.

All expenses to be incurred relative to the conduct of the activity, such as meals, supplies, and other allowable incidental costs, shall be charged against the DENR Youth Desk Program funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The SCIS Director in coordination with the Director of HRDS is authorized to amend or reschedule the activity in case of conflict with other activities of the Department or unavailability of the participants.
