**SUBJECT : AMENDING SPECIAL ORDER NO. 2021-45 DATED 11 FEBRUARY 2021 AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF STRATEGIC WORKSHOP ON THE INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF ENR LAW ENFORCEMENT**


A team from USAID Project SIBOL shall serve as workshop facilitator and resource persons during the activity.
