SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF STRATEGIC PLANNING FOR THE CLIMATE CHANGE SERVICE AND GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE

In the interest of the service, and in view of the recently-concluded Work and Financial Plan preparation-cum programming, the conduct of strategic planning workshop for the Offices of Climate Change Service (CCS) and Gender and Development (GAD) Office on 3-4 December 2021 in Region 3 is hereby authorized. The objective of the workshop is to effectively align climate change and disaster risk resiliency plans and programs, as well as GAD plan and budget for 2022 into the plans of the Offices. This is also in pursuant to the implementation of DENR Administrative Order No. 2021-22 (*Guidelines on Mainstreaming, Cascading and Institutionalizing the Climate Change Concerns in the Environment and Natural Resources [ENR] Priority Programs*).

The following personnel are hereby authorized to participate in this activity:


- A. Staff from the Office of the Undersecretary for Finance, Information Systems and Climate Change
- B. Selected officials from DENR Region 3, PENROs/CENROs
- C. Staff from the Office of the Director, Climate Change Service and concurrent Gender and Development Office
- D. Technical staff from Climate Change Mainstreaming and Integration Division
- E. Technical staff from Climate Change Technical Information and Support Division

All expenses to be incurred in relation to this shall be charged against DENR funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. All safety and health protocols and prescribed minimum health standards such as, but not limited to wearing of face masks and face shields, and observance of social distancing shall be carried out.

Support staff from CCS and GAD Office shall serve as secretariat during the said event, and a report shall be submitted to the undersigned within fifteen (15) days after the completion of the said activity.

The Undersecretary for Finance, Information Systems and Climate Change is authorized to amend and reschedule the activity in case of conflict with other activities of the Department.

This Order shall take effect on the dates specified herein.
