**SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING CERTAIN DENR EMPLOYEES TO PURSUE 6<sup>TH</sup> CYCLE OF THE PROFESSIONAL MASTERS IN TROPICAL MARINE ECOSYSTEMS MANAGEMENT PROGRAM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES CAMPUSES**

In the interest of the service to capacitate qualified DENR employees in coastal and marine ecosystems, the following are hereby authorized to pursue the 6<sup>th</sup> Cycle of the Professional Masters in Tropical Marine Ecosystems Management (PM-TMEM) at the University of the Philippines (UP) Campuses for one (1) full academic cycle of one and a half year starting this 2<sup>nd</sup> Trimester A.Y. 2020-2021:

The above employees shall attend whole day classes through a blended learning modality with synchronous and asynchronous online classes via Zoom and Google Classroom, including alternative online activities in lieu of field exposures. However, they shall be required to report to their respective offices in between modules until the completion of the said program.

They shall receive full scholarship grant under the 6<sup>th</sup> Cycle of the Coastal and Marine Ecosystems Management Program (CMEMP) DPM-TMEM Scholarship pursuant to the Memorandum of Agreement by and between the Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) - DENR and the University of the Philippines (UP).

The DENR shall continue to pay their salaries, and other emoluments and adjustments, subject to existing scholarship guidelines and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force until the completion of the 6<sup>th</sup> Cycle of the PM-TMEM Program.
