However, they shall be required to report to their respective offices in between modules until the completion of the said program.

They shall receive full scholarship grant under the 6th Cycle of the Coastal and Marine Ecosystems Management Program (CMEMP) DPM-TMEM Scholarship pursuant to the Memorandum of Agreement by and between the Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) - DENR and the University of the Philippines (UP).

The DENR shall continue to pay their salaries, and other emoluments and adjustments, subject to existing scholarship guidelines and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force until the completion of the 6^{th} Cycle of the PM-TMEM Program.
