## **DENR SPECIAL ORDER** No. 2022 - 283

**SUBJECT** 

AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF COMMUNITY WOMEN CONSULTATION AND FORUM FOR TYPHOON ODETTE HIT AREAS ON APRIL 21-23, 2022 IN REGION 4B
