SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

EVENT ON ENVIRONMENTALLY SUSTAINABLE CITIES AND COASTAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ON MAY 25-28, 2022 IN

NEGROS OCCIDENTAL

In the interest of the service and in line with the implementation of the Manila Bay Rehabilitation Program pertinent to the Supreme Court Mandamus Order and Administrative Order No. 16, the conduct of Experiential Learning Event between DENR-NCR and LGUs of Negros Occidental on Environmentally Sustainable Cities (ESC) and Coastal Resource Management on May 25-28, 2022 in Negros Occidental is hereby authorized.

Two (2) resource persons highly involved in the ESC shall be invited as coordinators/speakers.

Three (3) representatives from the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office-Negros Occidental shall be sought for the assistance on the ground.

The attendance of participants shall be on official time. All expenses to be incurred relative to the conduct of the above-stated activity is chargeable against the DENR-NCR CY 2021 Manila Bay Continuing fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Should there be inclement weather condition or declaration of non-working holiday, conflict on the availability of flight schedules, schedule of the LGU and other concerned offices and/or declaration of lockdown on target sites, the activity shall be postponed or rescheduled by the Regional Executive Director of DENR-NCR. Physical distancing and health safety protocols shall be STRICTLY OBSERVED.

An activity report shall be submitted to the undersigned seven (7) days after the conduct of the activity as required under Memorandum dated 18 August 2017 on the Undersecretary for Legal, Administration, Human Resources and Legislative Affairs. Failure to attend shall be held responsible and will be required to explain in writing three (3) days after the event why they should not be administered liable, premised under Sec. 46, No. 25, Chapter 7-Discipline, Administrative Code 1987.

This Order shall take effect on the dates herein specified.
