
The FMB will request the participation of the representatives from the Presidential Agrarian Reform Council (PARC) Secretariat and officers of the National Federation of CBFM People's Organizations. Likewise, resource persons from government agencies shall be invited to discuss topics related to CBFM and CBFM-CARP.

All expenses to be incurred such as, but not limited to, mobile data/internet connection costs, supply/materials, and other fees/expenditures of/for FMB personnel, representatives from the PARC Secretariat and officers of the National Federation of CBFM People's Organizations; and honoraria for resource person/s shall be charged against FMB Fund 101 (CBFM-CARP). On the other hand, all expenses to be incurred for DENR Central and Regional Offices' participants shall be charged against their respective offices, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The Director of Forest Management Bureau is authorized to reschedule the activity in case of conflict with other activities of the Department.

A report shall be submitted to the undersigned within fifteen (15) days after the completion of the activity.
