SPECIAL ORDER No. 2022 - 46

SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF ASSESSMENT AND STOCKTAKING ON VOLUNTEERISM FOR THE ENVIRONMENT SECTOR

In the interest of the service and in order to gather information from partner stakeholders regarding the current landscape of volunteering for the environment, the conduct of Assessment and Stocktaking on Volunteerism for the Environment Sector is hereby authorized on January 28, 2022 via Zoom Teleconferencing application.

The activity aims to provide a documented comprehensive assessment of the existing volunteer engagement from the different sectors for evaluation and future innovations in terms of volunteerism in line with the DENR mandate of conservation, protection and management of the nation's natural resources for the present and future generations.

This will be participated by various groups and partners from the academe, business and industry sectors, civil society and people's organizations, government agencies and/or government-owned and controlled corporations and other concerned partners and offices.

The Philippine National Volunteer Service Coordinating Agency will administer the consultation and shall be facilitated by the Strategic Communication and Initiatives Service.

All expenses to be incurred related to the activity shall be charged against SCIS funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

A report shall be submitted fifteen (15) working days after the conclusion of the activity.

The Undersecretary for Solid Waste Management and Local Government Units Concerns, and Supervising Undersecretary for Strategic Communication and Initiatives Service and Task Force Tayo Ang Kalikasan is hereby authorized to re-schedule the consultation when necessary.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
