SUBJECT : AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF SERIES OF CONSULTATION MEETINGS AND VALIDATION FOR THE ENHANCEMENT OF THE NATIONALLY DETERMINED CONTRIBUTIONS (NDC) POLICIES AND MEASURES FOR THE INDUSTRIAL PROCESSES AND PRODUCTS USE (IPPU) AND WASTE SECTORS ON OCTOBER 25-28, 2022 IN REGION 6

In the interest of the service, and in line with the commitments to the operationalization of the country's Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) of the Paris Agreement, the Climate Change Service is hereby authorized to conduct Focus Group Discussions and Site-Validation for the Enhancement of the NDC Policies and Measures for the IPPU and Waste Sectors on October 25-28, 2022 in Region 6.
