SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF A 3-EPISODAL FORUM ON LESSONS LEARNED, GOOD PRACTICES, INNOVATIONS AND SUCCESS STORIES WITH THE THEME “ADDRESSING FOREST DEGRADATION THROUGH NATURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT: THE NEGROS AND PANAY ISLAND EXPERIENCE”

In the interest of the service and to share the significant implementation experiences of foreign-assisted projects (FAPs), the conduct of a Forum on Lessons Learned, Good Practices, Innovations and Success Stories (LGIS) (blended face-to-face and virtual) is hereby authorized to be held on November 7-11, 2022 in Region 6.

This activity will be shared through social media platforms (i.e. via DENR-FASPS' Official Facebook page and Youtube channel) to allow other stakeholders to participate.



Further, the organizer shall ensure that the latest health protocols issued by the IATF are observed during the activity.

The Director for Foreign-Assisted and Special Projects Service is hereby authorized to amend and/or re-schedule the activity in case of conflict with other activities of the Department or unavailability of the Resource Persons.
