AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF ACTIVITIES IN OBSERVANCE OF THE CELEBRATION OF THE GLOBAL WARMING AND NATIONAL CLIMATE CHANGE CONSCIOUSNESS WEEK ON 19-25 NOVEMBER 2022

In the interest of service, and pursuant to Proclamation No. 1667, s. 2008, entitled "Global Warming and Climate Change Consciousness Week", and to pursue an intensive information and education campaign to help reduce greenhouse gas emissions and promote behavioral solutions to climate change and a sustainable lifestyle to our various stakeholders, the conduct of this year's Global Warming and National Climate Change Consciousness Week from 19-25 November 2022, with the theme "Sama-samang Tutugon sa Hamon ng Nagbabagong Klima" is hereby authorized.

Offices of the DENR at the Central and Regional level, Bureaus, and Attached Agencies are also advised to mount their respective support activities. For the DENR Central Office, attached as Annex 1 is the line up of activities for the week-long celebration.

Expenses to be incurred in the conduct of the event, including but not limited to food for the preparations and awarding ceremonies for the Mga Kwentong Klima-likasan, and the Sining-Likhasan, honoraria for judges, cash prizes, certificates for all entries, pot trophies, supplies, and other miscellaneous items shall be chargeable against the funds of the Gender and Development Office, Climate Change Service and the Task Force Build Back Better, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. A Special Disbursing Officer (SDO) shall likewise be authorized to hold cash advances to defray expenses on the activities stated herein.

The Undersecretary for Finance, Information System, and Climate Change is authorized to amend and reschedule the activity in case of conflict with other activities of the Department.

A report shall be submitted to the undersigned within fifteen (15) days after the orientation.

This order takes effect on the dates herein specified.
