Prior to this year-end workshop, involved DENR Regional focal will be asked to answer a diagnostic questionnaire to measure and assess their level of knowledge regarding the subject matter. They are required to submit an advance individual status report of accomplishments in conducting Carbon Stock Assessment. During the workshop, participants will be clustered according to their status/ level of accomplishment in conducting Carbon Stock Assessment (Clustering: 1- preliminary/site selection/ establishment of transects; 2- data gathering; 3- data analysis/ interpretation; 4- report writing). In every cluster, participants will present 5-10 slides on the status of accomplishment based on the report submitted before the workshop (see attached report format for submission and for presentation). Mentoring and coaching of different clusters (Supplemented learning activity) will be the last activity.


