AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF THE AFoCO-SUPPORTED TRAINING ON CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION AND MITIGATION (CCAM) AND DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (DRRM) FOR COMMUNITY-BASED FOREST MANAGEMENT-PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATIONS (CBFM-POs) ON 24-26 MAY 2023

The FMB shall serve as the over-all trainer, organizer, and documenter for the training. Nonetheless, the Bureau shall invite resource persons from other government agencies and/or non-government organizations/entities to provide lectures/learning sessions related to CCAM, DRRM and other relevant topics.

All expenses to be incurred by DENR staff, resource persons and CBFM-PO participants shall be charged against their respective offices and/or against AFoCO fund, whatever is applicable, in accordance with the approved budget plan, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The Director of Forest Management Bureau is authorized to reschedule the activity and/or change the venue in case of conflict with other activities of the Department.

A report shall be submitted online (bit.ly/LNDportal) to the undersigned through Human Resource Development Service – Training and Development Division, fifteen (15) days after the completion of the activity.
