SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF CONSULTATION ON THE DRAFT DEPARTMENT ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER (DAO) ON MAINSTREAMING THE INTEGRATED COASTAL MANAGEMENT (ICM) APPROACH INTO THE COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE PLAN (CLUP) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS (LGUS)

In line with the continuous efforts of the Bureau on mainstreaming the ICM into the LGUs' CLUP the Technical Bulletin No. 2022-02 will be elevated into a Department Administrative Order (DAO). The BMB Director is authorized to change the date and time of activities, as necessary, and conflict of schedule with other priority programs of the DENR, among others. The BMB shall notify HRDS of the changes.

The BMB shall submit a consolidated report to the undersigned through this link bit.ly/LNDportal within 15 days after the completion of the activities of the celebration.

This Order shall take effect on the dates herein specified.
