SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF THE PROTECTED AREA BOUNDARY DEMARCATION VIRTUAL CONSULTATION AND FEEDBACKING WORKSHOP

Expenses to be incurred in the conduct of the Workshop such as food, accommodation, venue, and supplies and materials shall be charged to the funds of BMB, while transportation and other traveling expenses of the participants shall be charged to their respective offices, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The attendance during Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays for the aforementioned workshop shall be considered an official time. Contract of Service employees who attend the event and incur official time exceeding (22) days in a month will be entitled to a compensatory time-off privilege. This privilege can be availed within the year and will be equivalent to the total excess official time incurred for the month of the workshop.

A report shall be submitted online (bitly/LNDportal) to the undersigned through the Human Resource Development Service-Training and Development Division, fifteen (15) days after the completion of the activity.

Any changes in the schedule shall be submitted to the HRDS for records purposes.
