The Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB), as the executing agency for the Project, may invite a facilitator for the activity. Expenses for the honorarium of the said facilitator shall be charged against BMB-National Parks Division funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
