The CCS Director is authorized to adjust the date and location of the subject activity as exigencies may warrant. Any changes in the schedule shall be submitted to the HRDS for recording purposes. Should a session day fall on a holiday or a weekend, all learners and staff shall be entitled to Compensatory Time Off (CTO).
