AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF MGA KWENTONG KLIMA-LIKASAN: A CLIMATE AND DISASTER RESILIENCY RECOGNITION AWARDS 2023

In the interest of service, and pursuant to Proclamation No. 1667, s. 2008, entitled "Global Warming and Climate Change Consciousness Week" with this year's theme, "Bayanihan Para sa Klima: Bagong Bansang Matagatag", and provide a platform to recognize the significant contributions and efforts of individuals, organizations, and local government units in addressing environmental issues, climate change, and disaster risk reduction, the conduct of Mga Kwentong Klima-Likasan Recognition Awards 2023 at Armada Hotel, M.H. del Pilar St., Manila on November 22, 2023 is hereby authorized.

The Climate Change Service shall serve as the secretariat. Further, they shall invite the winners to attend the awarding ceremony.

By showcasing the stories and narratives of these changemakers, the awards aim to highlight their initiatives, good practices, experiences, lessons learned, and successful strategies within their respective communities. This recognition scheme also plays a crucial role in promoting awareness, inspiring others, and fostering a sense of collective responsibility for environmental conservation and climate action.

Mga Kwentong KLIMA-likasan Recognition Awards is a support activity for the Global Good Stories Movement. Selected stories from the submissions will be officially communicated and submitted to the Good Stories Movement.

Expenses to be incurred relative to the conduct of the event, including food for the preparations and awarding ceremonies for the Mga Kwentong Klima-likasan, resource persons' fees, cash prizes, certificates for all entries, trophies, supplies, travel expenses of winners, supplies/materials, and other miscellaneous items shall be chargeable against the funds of the Climate Change Service and Gender and Development Office, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

A report shall be submitted online (bit.ly/LNDportal) to the undersigned through the Human Resource Development Service (HRDS) - Training and Development Division, fifteen (15) days after the completion of the activity.

The Director of the Climate Change Service is authorized to amend and reschedule the activity in case of conflict with other activities of the Department. Any changes in the schedule shall be submitted to the HRDS for records purposes.

A report shall be submitted to the undersigned within fifteen (15) days after the orientation.

This order takes effect on the dates herein specified.
