> SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF THE PRE-SB 60 CAPACITY BUILDING AND WRITESHOP ON 3 - 5 APRIL 2024 IN REGION 4A

In the interest of the service, and in line with the commitments to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the Climate Change Service is hereby authorized to conduct the Pre-SB 60 Capacity Building and Writeshop on 3 - 5 April 2024 in Region 4A.

This three day activity is envisioned as a preparatory training and a writeshop to develop country positions for UNFCCC SB 60, scheduled from 3 to 13 June 2024, in Bonn, Germany. It is intended for prospective members of the Philippine delegation to these subsidiary bodies meetings, as well as personnel assigned to the Manila Support Hubs for their agencies.
