All expenses to be incurred shall be charged against the DENR Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Traveling expenses, including honoraria of the resource persons, food, and accommodation expenses during the event of the six (6) Resource Speakers from the United States Agency International Development- Sustainable Interventions for Biodiversity Oceans and Landscape (USAID-SIBOL) shall be shouldered by the DENR.

Travel expenses of representatives from and to their place of assignment and other allowable expenses shall be charged against respective office funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The Climate Change Service (CCS) staff, together with the representatives of USAID SIBOL shall serve as resource persons for the entire duration of the activity. The concerned DENR PENRO Rizal in coordination with the DENR CCS shall serve as the Secretariat.

The Director of the Climate Change Service is authorized to amend the date and venue of the said activity in case of conflict with other activities of the Department or unavailability of the resource persons/subject matter experts.

A report shall be submitted online (bit.ly/LNDportal) by the Climate Change Service to the undersigned through the Human Resource Development Service - Training and Development Division fifteen (15) working days after the completion of the activity.

This Order shall take effect immediately on the dates specified herein.
