Subject: DESIGNATING MEMBERS OF THE INTERNAL TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) OF THE DENR FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF RA 11234 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ENERGY VIRTUAL ONE-STOP SHOP (EVOSS) ACT

In the interest of the service and as part of the continuing coordination with the Department of Energy (DOE) to fulfill the DENR's responsibilities and obligations to the implementation of Republic Act No. 11234 otherwise known as the Energy Virtual One-Stop Shop (EVOSS) Act, the following Personnel are hereby designated to comprise the Technical Working Group for the purpose of integration of energy-related processes of the DENR into the EVOSS system:

They shall perform the following duties and functions appurtenant thereto upon assumption of duty subject to existing rules and regulations, to wit:

- a) Actively participate in the DENR level EVOSS-related meetings;
- b) Meet regularly and submit report until the EVOSS is established and becomes fully operational;
- c) Coordinate with the DOE on the setting-up and operationalization of the EVOSS;

- d) Continually review internal process flows to eliminate causes of delays in the processing of permits and clearances of all power generation, transmission, and distribution projects through EVOSS;
- e) Recommend improvement on the internal electronic permitting and clearance systems to the Office of the Secretary or the Undersecretary that oversees the implementation of the EVOSS;

This Order shall take effect immediately and remain in force unless revoked in writing.
