SUBJECT: Deregulation of the Harvesting,

Transporting and Sale of Firewood, Pulpwood or Timber Planted in Private

Lands

In consonance with the National Forestation Program and in order to promote the planting of trees by owners of private lands, the restrictions on the harvesting, transporting and sale of firewood, pulpwood or timber produced from Ipil-ipil (Leucaena spp.) and falcata (Albizzia falcataria) planted in private lands are hereby lifted. The ban on the cutting of bamboos in Laguna and Rizal under Ministry Order No. 37, series of 1986, insofar as private lands are concerned, is likewise lifted.

All MNR/BFD administrative orders, memoranda, or circulars inconsistent with this Order are hereby revoked or modified accordingly.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
