SUBJECT Designation of Members of the Governing Board for Metro Cagayan De Oro Airshed, Province of Misamis Oriental, Region X.

In the interest of public service and pursuant to Section 9 of the Republic Act 8749, otherwise known as the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999, and Sections 4 and 5 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (DAO 2000-81) of the said Act and to effectively carry out the Metro Cagayan de Oro airshed's air quality action plans, a Governing Board (herein referred to as the Board) is hereby created.

The Board shall be headed by the Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, as Chairman. The Department's Regional Executive Director and the Bureau's Regional Director of Region X shall be designated as Deputy Chairpersons.

The Members of the Board shall be initially composed of the following:

- a. The Provincial Governor of Misamis Oriental
- b. The Mayors of the following:
 - i. Cagayan de Oro City
 - ii. Municipalities of Jasaan, Villanueva, Tagoloan, Opol and El Salvador.
- c. Administrator of PHIVIDEC Industrial Estate.
- d. The Regional Directors of the following:
 - i. Dept. of Transportation and Communication-Land Transportation Office
 - ii. Department of Health
 - iii. Department of Trade and Industry
 - iv. Department of Science and Technology-PAGASA
 - v. Department of Energy
- e. Representative from the private sector, people's organization and non-governmental organization who shall within six (6) months from the designation of the airshed be chosen by, and among themselves through sectoral assemblies concerned. The number of representatives shall be in a ratio of 5:2:2 (government-private sector-civil society)


The members of the Governing Board shall serve for a term of three (3) years (or such lesser time as may be permitted by the term of Office, if publicly elected officials) without compensation except for actual and necessary expenses incurred in

When a vacancy occurs during the term of a member from PO, NGO or Private Business Sector, a new member shall be appointed by the Governing Board for the remainder of the unfinished term.

The Governing Board shall perform the following functions:

- (1) Formulation of policies and standard-setting subject to laws of national application;
- (2) Preparation of common action plan;
- (3) Coordination of functions among its members; and
- (4) Submission and publication of annual Air Quality Status Report
