DENR ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

No. 2005 - 11

SUBJECT : Establishment of the Metropolitan Iloilo Airshed and its Governing Board

Pursuant to Sections 8 and 9 of the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999 (Republic Act 8749) and Sections 1 to 11, Rule XV, Part V of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (DENR Administrative Order No. 2000-81), the Metropolitan Iloilo Airshed and its Governing Board is hereby created.

Section 1. Coverage of the Airshed.

The airshed comprises of one (1) city and four (4) municipalities namely:

1. Iloilo City
2. Municipality of Oton
3. Municipality of San Miguel
4. Municipality of Pavia
5. Municipality of Leganes

Section 2. Review and/or Revision of the Coverage of the Airshed.

Pursuant to Sections 1 and 2, Rule XV, Part V of DAO 2000-81 and upon consultation with appropriate local government authorities, the Secretary of the Department, upon recommendation of the Bureau shall, from time to time, review, revise, amend and/or expand the designation of the airshed utilizing eco-profiling techniques and undertaking of scientific studies.

Section 3. Composition of Metropolitan Iloilo Airshed Governing Board.

To effectively carry out the action plans, a Governing Board is hereby created herein referred to as the Board.

The Board shall be headed by the Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. The Regional Director of Environmental Management Bureau, Region VI shall act as Deputy Chairperson.

The Board shall be composed of the following as members:

- a. The Provincial Governor of Iloilo
- b. The City Mayor of Iloilo City and the Municipal Mayors of Oton, San Miguel, Pavia and Leganes
- c. The Regional Directors of the following:
 1. Department of Transportation and Communication
- Land Transportation Office
 2. Department of Health
 3. Department of Trade and Industry
 4. Department of the Interior and Local Government
 5. Department of Science and Technology



Section 4. Term of Office.

Members of the Governing Board shall serve for three (3) years (or such lesser time as may be permitted by the term of office, if publicly elected officials) without compensation except for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

When a vacancy occurs during the term of a member from the Peoples Organizations (PO), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) or Private Business Sector, a new member shall be appointed by the Governing Board for the remainder of the unfinished term.

Section 5. Functions of the Board.

The Board shall perform the following functions:


- a. Formulation of policies;
- b. Preparation of common action plan;
- c. Coordination of functions among its members; and
- d. Submission and publication of annual air quality status report for each airshed.

Section 6. Separability Clause.

Should any provision of this Order be declared unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity or the legality of the other provisions.

Section 7. Effectivity.

This Order shall take effect immediately upon the acknowledgement by the Office of the National Administration Registry (ONAR), UP Law Center and fifteen (15) days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
