MODIFICATIONS TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION IN THE PROVINCE OF AURORA, REGION 3

In cognizance of the economic value and tourist potential of the abundant biodiversity in the Province of Aurora, as well as to promote its environmental protection and resource conservation, modifications to the administrative and territorial jurisdiction of the municipalities in said province are hereby promulgated.

The Community Environment and Natural Rescurces Office (CENRO) of Maria Aurora is hereby transferred to Baler, Aurora to ensure effective delivery of services to the public. Hence, the Municipality of Baler, Aurora shall be transferred from CENRO Dingalan and placed under the administrative jurisdiction of CENRO Baler. Furthermore, the Baler Sub-Office shall be transferred to the Municipality of San Luis.

In reference to the personnel complement and arrangement, financial requirements and other logistics for the operation of each CENRO, the existing manpower and budget allotment shall be utilized and redistributed according to its new administrative jurisdiction.

Upon the issuance of this Order, the new administrative and territorial jurisdiction of CENROs in Aurora Province shall be composed of the following municipalities:

In order to implement an orderly transfer of personnel, documents, equipment, and other DENR property to the new office, a Committee shall oversee the inventory, audit and transfer to be chaired by the Regional Executive Director or his duly authorized representative.

This Order shall take effect immediately and all Orders inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed or amended accordingly.
