Transferring the Tamaraw Conservation Program (TCP) from the Protected Areas and Wildlife Bureau (PAWB) to DENR Region IVB-MIMAROPA through PENRO Occidental Mindoro

The supervision, operations and management of the Tamaraw Conservation Program (TCP) is hereby transferred to DENR-Region IVB-MIMAROPA through the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO), Occidental Mindoro. The remaining months for CY 2005 will serve as the transition period.

All functions and responsibilities, including personnel and staff; records; equipment and supplies; and Project appropriations for CY 2006 are hereby included in the transfer. Such transfer of TCP personnel and staff excludes all PAWB personnel assigned to the Project.

Within three (3) months from the effectivity of this Order, the DENR Region IVB-MIMAROPA, PENRO Occidental Mindoro and PAWB shall jointly develop a management framework that will guide the PENRO Occidental Mindoro for the operation of the TCP. PAWB shall continue its responsibilities to oversee the operations of the Project under this Order. For this purpose, the PENRO Occidental Mindoro shall submit progress reports to PAWB through DENR Region IVB-MIMAROPA.

This Order revokes DENR Administrative Order No. 99-02 and takes effect immediately.
