SUBJECT : CREATION OF AD HOC TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) TO FORMULATE GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT AND APPROVAL OF RECLAMATION ACTIVITIES

The following are the responsibilities of the TWG:

1. Identify the existing DENR policies and procedures related to reclamation activities;
2. Draft DENR position on the procedures and processes pertaining to reclamation and the subsequent activities involved (i.e. titling);





3. In coordination with the counterpart teams from the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and Philippine Estates Authority (PEA), formulate the tripartite procedures for the conduct of reclamation and subsequent activities;
4. Participate in the conduct of public consultations and/or discussions of the formulated tripartite procedures;
5. Recommend to the DENR management the adoption of the procedures;
6. Perform other activities as may be necessary to achieve the objectives of the TWG.

Funds for this purpose shall be charged against the budget of their respective offices.

This Special Order shall take effect immediately and shall be terminated upon the issuance of the joint guidelines.
