In addition, they shall also bring with them basic SCUBA gears, if available.

Traveling expenses and per diems of the participants from their official station to Manila and back shall be borne by their respective offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

MERF Inc. shall bear all other Training-related expenses of the participants such as accommodation, meals and transportation from Manila to Puerto Galera, Occidental Mindoro and back.

The above-mentioned participants shall serve as the DENR's Core Group in Biophysical and Socio-economic Monitoring of Marine Protected Areas/Coastal Areas under the administrative authority of the DENR. They shall also serve as the focal person in monitoring priority coastal and marine protected areas within their Region.
