**SUBJECT: CREATION OF A TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) FOR THE REVISION OF THE PROJECT DESIGN FOR THE CAMIGUIN COASTAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PROJECT**

As such, the TWG shall perform the following functions:

- 1.0 Conduct a writeshop/workshop that will be facilitated by the Tetra Tech EM, Inc. (CCRMP-Project Design Consultants) to refine the project design report, focusing on:
  - 1.1 clear definition of the roles of each active major player in the project
  - 1.2 preparation of the Memorandum of Agreements (MOA) for project implementation arrangements
- 2.0 Review and recommend strategies for effective and smooth implementation of the project;
- 3.0 Assist in the identification of potential key persons in each participating LGU as well as provide guidance to these players during the design and in the course of the project pre-implementation stage; and
- 4.0 Guide the participating LGUs in the identification of the pilot projects with the application of the recommended strategies on coastal resource management plans/programs and within the priorities of the NZAID Development Strategy.

Any expenses incurred by the TWG in the performance of its functions shall be chargeable against the funds of the respective offices of the members in accordance with existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
