Pursuant to the memorandum of Executive Secretary Eduardo R. Ermita dated January 2, 2006 and as stated in President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo's New Year Message, the President's focus/vision for the country is in terms of social reforms, economic take-off and pursuance of the fight against poverty, hunger and unemployment. The President wishes to intensify the implementation of much needed reforms to uplift the lives of average Filipinos.

Providing more jobs, investments, infrastructure and socioeconomic relief for those most in need should be our priority. The following are, among others, the five major activities to be focused on:

- 1. Public Works –especially those providing emergency employment
- 2. Housing particularly relocation programs for the Northrail and Southrail
- 3. Food- feeding program
- 4. PhilHealth coverage of PhilHealth cards and one-half priced medicines
- 5. Education closing the gap for barangays in need of school buildings

In particular, the Department needs to focus on activity numbers 2 and 4.

As declared by the President, it is "now the time to leave the past behind and for all Filipinos to join hands in the great national effort to win the race for economic excellence."
